Artists celebrate art and music on Labour Day weekend

Local artist and musician Scott MacLeod is one of the 15 artists invited to participate in "Love and The Machine", a one night event at the SAT (Societe des arts technologiques) that will feature work from a variety of musicians, artists and fashion designers this Saturday evening at 1195 St. Laurent Boulevard. MacLeod was recently awarded the prestigious Artistic research and creation grant from the Conseil des arts et des lettres du Quebec for his current project, the Sacred Feminine and Masculine, Labyrinthina. The photography and video installation, inspired by sacred geometry, archaeology, and archetypal mythology deals with the seven stages of life; birth, innocence, teens, maidenhood/young man, mother/father, wise-woman/man and finally the

elder/death. In this installation the photographs are juxtaposed by two videos, one depicting the life cycle of an oak tree and the second dealing with circular symbols such as the yin and yang, Celtic shields, mandalas, and labyrinths that all reflect the circular nature of the cycle of life. The art vernissage is from 5 to 7 p.m. followed by entertainment. During the vernissage, Hip Hop artist Mr. Goodvibes will perform a freestyle piece inspired by the installation at 6 p.m. For more information call 487-8766.
